

## **Create a climate of change**

In August 2006 hundreds of people gathered in the shadow of the UK's biggest CO2 emitter, Drax power station, for an inspiring 10 days of education, sustainable living and direct action. **The Camp for Climate Action** sent a clear message that there is no place for Drax or the fossil fuel economy in a sustainable future - it showed the power we have when we take collective, creative action.

We have only a ten-year window to avert climate catastrophe - but the momentum to turn things around is growing. Demonstrations are important, but demonstrations alone can easily be ignored. To be successful, a movement for climate justice also needs to support and build networks committed to civil disobedience. Get involved in building this emerging movement committed to the grassroots solutions and actions needed to energise radical change.

**The Camp for Climate Action 2** has already taken place, on the taxiway of East Midlands Airport. You can help plan for **The Camp for Climate Action 3** and more, from co-ordinated days of action to campaign skill shares. Together, we are taking action to build the world we want.
